VICTORIAN PASTIMES

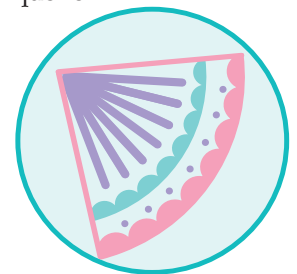
MARCH 2, 2019 • 1-3:30 PM

MORAVIAN MEMORIES

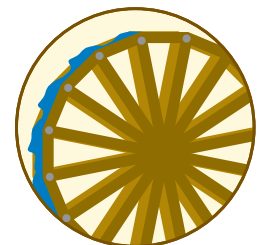
APRIL 27, 2019 • 1-4 PM
